

**WEST SADBURY TOWNSHIP  
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS WORK SESSION  
March 26, 2019**

1. A list of general fund invoices in the amount of \$4,712.74 was presented to the Board. Barry Edwards made a motion to pay the invoices, and John Keeseey seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.
2. Barry Edwards made a motion to authorize the sale of a mower deck in the amount of \$200.00 to Joe Prekup. John Keeseey seconded the motion, and motion passed 3-0.
3. A Performance Agreement for the Big Package Band to present a concert at the township on August 24, 2019 was presented to the Board. The agreement was tabled for the April 9, 2019 supervisors' meeting.
4. Cindy informed the Board that the manager of Sadsbury Township, Lancaster County has inquired about any interest the Township may have in the stone arch bridge that spans the creek between Sadsbury and West Sadsbury Township at the Lancaster County line. The Board is not interested in taking ownership of the bridge.
5. Joe Prekup informed the board that he is getting prices to do tar and chip for some of the roads. He recommends that the Township pave Newlin Drive and is getting a price on that as well.
6. Chief Fidler has gotten estimates for AED's. He has applied for a Walmart grant to help cover the cost, which would be around \$1,100 per unit.
7. Ed Haas informed the Board that there will be a special meeting of the KVFD tomorrow night.
8. Barry informed the Board that at tonight's planning commission meeting, they will be considering changes to the zoning regulations for keeping horses and for horse barns. John Keeseey said he likes the idea of requiring a conditional use hearing for keeping a horse and building a horse barn on a lot size of 1 acre. Barry suggested creating a zoning district such as "residential development," in which no large animals would be permitted.

As there was no further business, the meeting adjourned at 10:41 a.m.
