TRASH REMOVAL AND

RECYCLING – All Township citizens are required by ordinance to use the services of municipal waste haulers, and recycling is mandatory. Residents are free to contract with any hauler. The hauler will provide you with a recycling container. When contracting with a hauler, you should establish how the company will accept the recyclable items for the collection process. Available haulers are as follows:

Residents may also collect recyclables and take them to Beartown Recycling or the Lanchester Landfill. Scrap metal usually has a monetary value and may be taken to scrap metal dealers like Atglen Recycling, Beartown Recycling, Bannons Metals, Harris Metals, and Metal Fabricating Co.

SEPTIC SYSTEMS – By ordinance, ALL property owners in the Township are required to have their on-site septic systems pumped by a licensed hauler at least once every three years. Having your septic system pumped regularly is the best way to help prevent costly repairs to the system. If you are not sure when your tank was last pumped, contact the Township to see if there is a record of it in the office. After having your septic tank pumped, a copy of the hauling receipt should be provided to the Township. For a list of licensed haulers, please call the Township office.
