

**WEST SADBURY TOWNSHIP**  
**BOARD OF SUPERVISORS WORK SESSION**  
**May 28, 2019**

Supervisors and Staff In Attendance – Barry Edwards, John Keesey, Edward Haas, Cindy Mammarella, and Luke Fidler

1. A list of outstanding invoices, including \$5,659.19 in general fund expenses and \$150.00 in liquid fuels expenses was presented to the Board. Barry Edwards made a motion to approve paying the invoices, and John Keesey seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.
2. A check in the amount of \$32,379.69 that represents a return of a majority of Donald Kauffman's financial security was prepared. The return of the financial security was previously approved by the Supervisors at their 5/14/19 meeting.
3. To confirm previous authorization for Cindy to advertise for a roadmaster, John Keesey made a motion to authorize advertising for a roadmaster, and Barry Edwards seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.
4. To confirm previous authorization for Cindy to advertise for an administrative assistant, John Keesey made a motion to authorize advertising for an administrative assistant, and Barry Edwards seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.
5. Information regarding surrounding municipalities and their costs to provide fire and ambulance services to their constituents was discussed. Copies of the information will be given to the supervisors.
6. Chief Fidler discussed with the Board hiring a part-time police officer as he stated that he is having trouble filling shifts. John Keesey asked that we look at the police budget to see where it stands. The Chief stated that he would rather pay a part-time officer than have to pay overtime. The Chief stated that he is hopeful that Officer Moore will be cleared for full duty shortly.
7. Barry asked for public comments. Joseph Prekup of Cemetery Road spoke up and informed the Board that he would be recording the comments portion of the meeting. He requested a copy of today's minutes. Mr. Prekup had several questions regarding the 2019 budgets. He was directed to provide the Township with a Right-To-Know request form to receive the copies. Additionally, Mr. Prekup commented on his resignation from the Township and circumstances regarding the same, including his lack of having a township-issued cell phone when he was employed by the Township. Edward Haas spoke up and made a motion to provide a township-issued cell phone for the Roads Department, and Barry Edwards seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0. Mr. Prekup continued to comment further on the circumstances surrounding his resignation.

At the conclusion of the comments, and with there being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 10:10 a.m.
