

Declaration of Disaster Emergency

February 22nd, 2026

WHEREAS, at or about 12:01am hours, on Sunday February 22, 2026, a snowstorm has caused or threatens to cause injury, damage, and suffering to the persons or property of West Sadsbury Township; and

WHEREAS, the snowstorm has endangered the health, safety and welfare of a substantial number of persons residing in West Sadsbury Township, and threatens to create problems greater in scope than West Sadsbury Township may be able to resolve; and


WHEREAS, emergency management measures are required to reduce the severity of this disaster and to protect the health, safety and welfare of affected residents in West Sadsbury Township; and


NOW, THEREFORE, we, the undersigned Board of Supervisors of the West Sadsbury Township, pursuant to the provisions of Section 7501 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, (35 PA C.S.), as amended, do hereby declare the existence of a disaster emergency in Chester County;

FURTHER, we direct the Emergency Management Coordinator, to coordinate the activities of emergency response, to take all appropriate action needed to alleviate the effects of this disaster, to aid in the restoration of essential public services, and to take any other emergency response action deemed necessary to respond to this disaster emergency.
